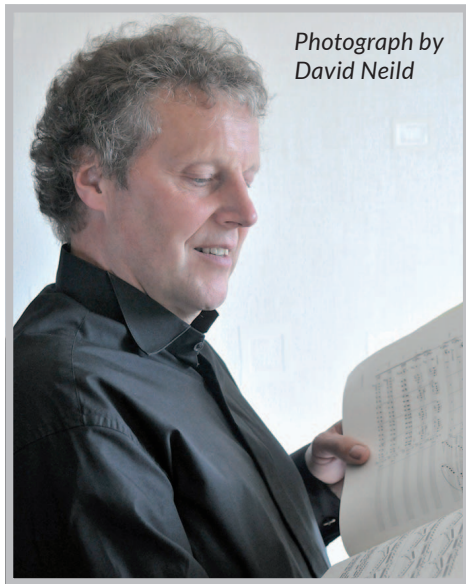

Bryan has been directing the orchestra since March 1985 and has recently celebrated his 30th year concert with the HSO. He retired (albeit a little early) from his post as Head of Music and Advanced Skills Teacher at King James's School in Knaresborough, having taught locally since 1976: initially at the High (Granby) School for 14 years and then for 20 years at Knaresborough. His job enabled him to work with primary and secondary school children and staff throughout North Yorkshire. As a result of his enthusiasm for developing young musical minds, he has been instrumental in offering opportunities for youngsters to experience quality music making. This includes performing in Christmas concerts with the HCS at the Conference Centre every year, workshop performances and concerts programmes specifically designed for children and their parents.

In 2013 he was guest conductor for the Amadeus Chamber Orchestra in Buenos Aires. Bryan is also founder and Musical Director of the Nidderdale Community Orchestra. In 2010 the Rotary Foundation of Rotary International presented him a Fellowship award. The Paul Harris Fellow was awarded in "appreciation of tangible and significant assistance given for the furtherance of better understanding and friendly relations among peoples of the world" and in particular for his exceptional services to the community.
